



Your Child Qualifies for a Tutoring Scholarship!!

Your child is eligible for a tutoring scholarship under the *No Child Left Behind Act* (NCLB) and the federal income limits of this program. You may choose to enroll your child in a **NON-CREDIT** course of **FREE TUTORING** to improve their skills in Math and/or Reading.

These programs have been approved by the state department of education and will provide your child with tutoring that is coordinated with what is being taught in school.

Please note that maximum capacity is a distinct possibility, and at that point, students will be prioritized for limited placements (by specific grade levels and/or lowest achieving) while others would be placed on a waiting list. Therefore, **send in your application right away!**

Applications received after that date will be assigned tutoring on a first-come first-serve basis. Once all of the available spots are taken, your student will be placed on a waiting list.
